***WHAT IS THE PRIVATE INVESTIGATION, RECOVERY, AND SECURITY ADVISORY COUNCIL?  
WHAT ARE THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COUNCIL?***

---

The Private Investigation, Recovery, and Security Advisory Council (PIRSAC) is established by law. While it does not have policymaking authority, the Council does serve in an advisory capacity to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to give guidance on regulatory matters affecting the industries regulated under Chapter 493, Florida Statutes. In the past, the PIRSAC has provided advice on various issues (for example, the security officer and recovery agent training curriculum; proposed legislation concerning the ability of security officers to carry firearms with higher calibers; etc.).

***WHO SITS ON THE COUNCIL?***

---

The Council's 11 members are appointed to serve four-year terms by the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Nine of the 11 Council members must be individuals licensed pursuant to Chapter 493. These members represent the business interests of their respective industries and speak on behalf of the constituencies in those industries at the Council's regular meetings. One of the remaining Council seats must be a representative from the law enforcement community, while the other seat must be the owner of a business that contracts with a licensed investigative, security, or recovery agency for regulated services. ***WHEN DOES THE COUNCIL MEET?***

---

Meetings are held quarterly, usually in February, May, August, and November. Meetings are normally scheduled in central Florida as this is a meeting location convenient to interested parties throughout the state. The department publishes the exact meeting date and time approximately 30 days prior to the meeting on the FDACS's [Event Calendar](#). Meeting information can also be obtained by calling the Division of Licensing's Public Inquiry Center at (850) 245-5691.
